


Medication Administration Training

Certification 1 – Medication Administration Training

Power Point Presentations, Videos, & Return Demonstrations used in conjunction with ODDD curriculum to educate providers on:

- ✓ Safe administration of medications – oral, sublingual, topical, rectal, vaginal, optic, and otic

Continuing Education Courses

ABCS of Teaching Individuals with Low Literacy Skills about Diabetes – a 2-hr. continuing education course designed to assist the caregiver to understand, and educate individuals with low literacy skills about diabetes.

Basics of Blood Pressure Medications – a 2 hr. continuing education course to help caregivers understand the difference between different types of blood pressure medications and enable the caregiver to educate clients regarding the medications.

Communicating with the Cognitively Impaired – a 2 hour continuing education course that provides the learner with skills to assist with caring for individuals with negative behaviors; agitation, wandering, and paranoia.


Infection Control Review – a 2 hour continuing education course that reviews the basics of handwashing, and use of personal protective equipment

Nutrition and Obesity – a 2 hour continuing education course that explains the factors and health risks affecting overweight and obesity

Personal Care – a 2 hour continuing education course that assists the caregiver to become proficient at providing a resident with personal grooming and hygiene.

Proactively Supporting Behaviors – a 2 hr. continuing education course designed to assist the caregiver to utilize situations and opportunities to teach appropriate ways for people to interact within the environments in which they live, work and socialize.

Psychotropic Medication & Tardive Dyskinesia – a 2hr. continuing education course designed to educate the learner about various psychotropic medication used to treat individuals with cognitive disabilities and possible side effects of the medications.
